The six dimensions that make two quotes comparable

Dimension	Ask the clinic	Why it moves the price
Cell type	Which cells, from which tissue (Wharton's jelly, bone marrow, adipose, exosome product)?	Manufacturing route and donor screening differ by source
Dose	How many cells per session, as a number, and how many sessions?	The single biggest cost driver
Hospital	Is admission, imaging and anaesthesia inside the price?	Day case vs inpatient differs by EUR 800-3,000
Accommodation	How many nights, what standard, transfers included?	Bundling makes a headline price look higher than an unbundled one
Follow-up	How many reviews, over what period, conducted by whom?	Per-visit follow-up is easily left out of a headline price
Laboratory documentation	Will you receive a batch release certificate (identity, viability, sterility, endotoxin, mycoplasma)?	Release testing is a real cost; omitting it lowers price and assurance together

Do the like-for-like arithmetic on paper

Add back every item a quote excludes, then divide by the total cells offered: hospital costs +EUR 1,800 · accommodation and transfers +EUR 900 · twelve months of follow-up +EUR 700 · batch release testing +EUR 600. These are mid-points of the separately billed ranges in the full report, for comparison only. A lower comparable total is not evidence of a better clinical outcome.

Country-specific regulatory notes

Country	Position on cell therapy outside a trial	Effect on price
Turkiye	Cell manufacture and the treating hospital are separately licensed and inspected by the Ministry of Health; treatment outside a trial is possible within that framework for defined indications.	Licensed manufacture and hospital administration are inside a legitimate quote
United States	The FDA regulates most cultured cell products as biologics requiring approval or an IND, and has issued repeated warnings about unapproved stem cell products.	Lawful access is largely via trials; advertised prices vary enormously

Country	Position on cell therapy outside a trial	Effect on price
United Kingdom	The MHRA regulates advanced therapy medicinal products; routine private provision outside a trial or specials framework is restricted.	Published private fees usually cover PRP or minimally manipulated products
Germany and EU	EMA and national authorities regulate ATMPs; a hospital exemption exists in some member states under strict conditions.	Where lawful, ATMP-grade manufacture raises cost substantially
Mexico, Panama	National frameworks permit some cell therapy outside trials; requirements and enforcement differ from the EU and US.	Prices sit between Turkiye and the US, with wide variation in documentation

Correction: JCI accreditation and Turkish licensing are different things

Ministry of Health licensing is the national requirement and applies to the manufacturing facility and the treating hospital; it is what makes treatment lawful. JCI accreditation is a voluntary international hospital accreditation programme, not a Turkish legal requirement, and JCI does not accredit GMP laboratories. GMP certification of a manufacturing site is separate again and is issued under the national framework. Verify each claim with the issuing body rather than with the clinic.

Before you pay, get these in writing

1. Cell type, cell dose and route, stated numerically. 2. Whether a release certificate for your batch will be issued. 3. Which hospital costs are inside the quote. 4. How many sessions the price covers and what a repeat costs. 5. The follow-up schedule and who provides it. 6. Deposit, refund and rescheduling terms.
